## the wine

The grapes for the Kings Ridge 2004 Syrah Cabernet come from vineyards in Washington State's renowned Columbia Valley. Each of these vineyards imparts their own distinctive style, and through our blending of the vineyards and varietals, we make this distinctive wine.

This is a wine with incredible depth and structure highlighted by juicy fruit and pronounced spice. Our 2004 Syrah Cabernet is made in a Rhone style with bigger, riper fruit that truly reflects the vintage. Beautiful aromas of dark cherries, hyacinth, brown sugar, nutmeg and clove fill the nose. The mouth shows bright cherry flavors integrated with coffee bean, pomegranate and plum, followed by a long finish laced with cinnamon.

## the vintage

A very warm growing season in 2004 led to an early harvest with small berry size and concentrated quality fruit. Fall was much cooler, stretching harvest of the last grapes well into the beginning of November. The profile of the 2004 wines is highly aromatic with medium body. 2004 was similar to 2002, with big, bold fruit. These wines will be approachable earlier.
